The Physical Society of Japan Online Journal Institutional User License Agreement

1. Grant of license

The institutional subscriber (hereinafter referred to as the "Subscriber"), having agreed to the terms and conditions regulated by this license agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement"), shall subscribe to the journal indicated below published by the Physical Society of Japan (hereinafter referred to as "the JPS"). The JPS shall provide an online version of the journal indicated below and allow the Subscriber to access it on a subscription basis in accordance with the terms and conditions regulated by this Agreement. The Subscriber shall have the right to access the online versions of the journal with the approval of the JPS.

Journal of the Physical Society of Japan (hereinafter referred to as "the JPSJ")

2. Copyright

The JPS shall retain the copyright for printed and online versions of the JPSJ. All content provided as part of the online journal is protected by the Copyright Law of Japan and is subject to all applicable laws and regulations. Copyright notices in the JPSJ and articles may not be removed, altered or obscured in any way.

3. Authorized site and users

The JPS shall permit the Subscriber to access online versions of the journal to which a subscription has been made via the authorized site for the Subscriber. This permission is granted exclusively to the Subscriber; it may not be transferred to non-subscribers, nor can the scope of permission be expanded. Under this Agreement, the term "authorized site" refers to local Internet protocol ("IP") address(es) supervised by the Subscriber. "Authorized user" refers to staff, faculty members and students who are registered with the Subscriber at the authorized site and persons granted legal permission to use the IP address(es) of that site. The JPS shall control access to the JPSJ online journal for institutional subscribers by screening IP addresses. Registration of IP addresses at the authorized site is limited to those officially allocated to the Subscriber. With respect to the range of the site, further discussions are to be held between the Subscriber and the JPS.

4. Usage Statistics

5. Conditions and restrictions of use

The Subscriber shall access the JPSJ online journal only by methods conforming to applicable laws and regulations. In principle, Subscribers shall be able to search, view, retrieve, display, save, download or print the JPSJ online journal for individual use only. For other uses, Subscribers are subject to the regulations stipulated by the JPS.

Systematic or large-volume downloading of the JPSJ online journal (for example, programmatic downloading of all papers published in one issue) is prohibited. Actions impairing the operation of the JPSJ online journal (for example, abnormally frequent access) are also prohibited.

6. Detection of prohibited use

The Subscriber is responsible for taking reasonable measures to prevent prohibited use, and shall promptly notify the JPS of any infringements of copyright or prohibited use of which it becomes aware. The Subscriber shall cooperate with the JPS in investigating any prohibited use, and shall take reasonable steps to ensure the cessation of such activity and to prevent any reoccurrence.

Disclaimer of warranties

The JPS shall make reasonable efforts to ensure that the JPSJ online journal and its content are complete and accurate. However, it shall not warrant their authenticity, security, accuracy, applicability or usability, and does not guarantee that the Subscriber's access to the journal will be uninterrupted or error-free, or that online journal service will be available in any and all circumstances.

The JPS shall not be liable for any damages arising from the use of the online journal service or from the inability to access online journals, nor shall it be liable for downtime arising from force majeure including, but not limited to, data updates, provider maintenance or technical failure.

8. Term and termination

This Agreement will remain valid until the end of the calendar year in which the subscription first becomes effective. It will remain in effect thereafter for successive calendar years as long as annual subscription fees are paid. The Agreement will terminate if and when subscription lapses.

The JPS shall have the right at any time to terminate this Agreement forthwith without prior notice in the event of the breach of any of the terms and conditions of the Agreement by the Subscriber.

9. Post-Cancellation Access

The subscribers to online version of the JPSJ are eligible for post-cancellation (perpetual) access. Post-cancellation access applies only to content published during the subscription term from 2014 onward.

10. General

This Agreement is subject to change without notice.
