

## Implementation Guidelines for Student Presentation Award of the Physical Society of Japan

December 9, 2017 Board of Directors

(0) Purpose:

To encourage excellent presentations by young researchers at the Physical Society of Japan (JPS) meetings and to further invigorate these meetings, this award is established.

(1) Award Name and Certificate:

The name of the award is the "Student Presentation Award of the Physical Society of Japan." The certificate will be awarded in the name of the President of the Physical Society of Japan.

(2) Eligibility:

Presentations (oral or poster) at the meeting by graduate student members or student members of the Physical Society of Japan are eligible for the award.

(3) Selection of Awardees:

The President/Board of Directors will request nominations of award candidates from each Division Representative. In each Division, designated judges, as specified in Supplementary Provisions (1) and (2) below, will evaluate the presentations. Based on the results, each Division Representative will recommend the award candidates to the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors will review and approve the award recommendations.

(4) Announcement:

After the approval, the names of the awardees and the titles of their award-winning presentations will be announced on the web page of the Physical Society of Japan.

(5) Timing:

The award will be presented starting from the 2018 Autumn Meeting.

(6) Revocation:

If an awardee performs an act that damages the honor of the Society, the Board of Directors may revoke the award.

Supplementary Provisions:

- (1) Number of Awardees, etc.: The number of awardees will be determined by each Division within the scope that does not deviate from the purpose of the award, and in some Divisions, it may be possible to award without any recommendations.
- (2) Award Regulations and Examiners: Each Division Representative shall establish rules, including the method of selecting examiners for determining awardee candidates, and notify the Board of Directors for approval (initially and in case of changes). After the examination is completed, the Division Representative shall submit the list of examiners to the Board of Directors along with the list of awardee candidates for approval. Approval of the list of examiners by the Board of Directors is a necessary condition for approving the awardees.
- (3) Issuance of Temporary Certificates: In each Division, a temporary certificate may be issued once the recommendation is decided, without waiting for approval by the Board of Directors.
- (4) Number of Awards: Multiple awards are allowed. However, each Division may prohibit multiple awards in its own regulations.
